WinSport's ski and snowboard hill closure extended through Friday

CALGARY, Alta. – WinSport announced today that the ski and snowboard hill at Canada Olympic Park will remain closed through Friday, due to forecasted cold temperatures and high wind chills.

Environment Canada is calling for highs only near the -26C range Thursday, with a wind chill of -39C in the morning and -34C in the afternoon. With Thursday's overnight temperature expected to dip to -31C without the windchill, it is expected that the mercury will be slow to recover on Friday.

The Servus Tube Park will also be closed on Friday.

With Saturday's current forecast of near zero, it is expected the hill and tube park will re-open Saturday for regular operations.
